

# Point Count Worksheet for Paramedic to Associate Degree Nursing Transition

Students are selected according to a point system before applying to the Paramedic to ADN program, an applicant must satisfy all of the prerequisites prior to receiving the Paramedic to ADN application packet. Minimum Prerequisite Requirements for Paramedic to ADN:

- Valid, unrestricted National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians - Paramedic certification (NREMT-P) and a current,unrestricted North Carolina EMT Paramedic certification.
- Minimum of one year of EMT Paramedic work experience within 5 years.
- All listed ADN general education courses must be completed.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher for Lenoir Community College's ADN general education required courses.
- Grade of 'C' or higher in all courses.

**Math** - An applicant must have completed one of the following before receiving the ADN application packet: Students with a GPA less than 2.799 must enroll in developmental courses, students with a GPA of 2.8 or higher may register for any gateway English or Math course without mandatory additional supports, and students who do not have a high school GPA or other approved placement scores (SAT, ACT, etc.) are required to take the Developmental Education Placement Test or qualify for a Developmental Education Placement Test waiver.

- Math 035, Solving Equations and Inequalities; Graphing; Exponents and Polynomials; Rational/Radical Expressions and Equations; Quadratic Equations, Factoring, and Concepts of Functions will qualify a student to meet the Health Sciences and Nursing Math requirement.
- Students who have completed a college approved Math course such as Math-121, Math-122, Math-141, Math-143, Math-151, Math-152, Math-161, Math-171, Math-263, or Math-271 (w/ grade of C or better) may meet the math requirement. Students that receive credit for Math-110 will not qualify for placement into a Health Sciences and Nursing program (A10300FY Statement).
